

PROJECT RESULTS

The Climate Action Mirror and Local Climate Action Scoreboard

- Climate Action Mirrors 2018, 2019, and 2020
- 9 measures in focus, i.e. analysed in detail
- The Local Climate Action Scoreboard, with 54 indicators from 8 sectors/subsectors
- Methods for evaluating the impacts of selected measures on reducing air pollutants

Climate Path 2050

- Analyses of GHG emissions reduction potentials in all sectors and for new technologies
- Additional in-depth analyses of potentials on key issues
- 2 new models developed for projections of emissions and removals in the LUJUCF sector and macroeconomic impact assessment
- Revised and upgraded models for 6 other sectors and their subsectors
- Analysis of 6 GHG emissions reduction scenarios for 7 sectors and assessment of their impacts
- GHG emissions projections for Slovenia up to 2050 made for the first time
- The local planning tool Dashboard providing projections for buildings and passenger cars by municipality

Cooperation on decisions

- 20 in-depth interviews with decision-makers
- 33 workshops (12 plenary, 21 sectoral) as part of the analysis of GHG emissions reduction scenarios
- 3 plenary events and 4 workshops in the framework of monitoring the implementation of climate actions
- More than 1,400 participants from 200 organizations at events
- Background studies used in public discussions on the *Long-term Climate Strategy*

PROJECT IMPACTS

- The project contributes to better climate governance: the use of analytical bases for the Slovenian *Long-term Climate Strategy up to 2050* and in 6 other national and sectoral and 3 local strategic documents
- A strengthened network of experts
- 72 municipalities encompassing 41% of the total population of Slovenia participate in the Local Climate Action Scoreboard; 12 ministries and other organizations responsible for the implementation of climate actions at the national level were involved in project activities
- Raising awareness of climate policy implementation and planning: more than 200 publications in general or specialized media
- A high level of traffic on websites
- Indirect GHG emissions reduction and contribution to the achievement of Slovenia's targets if the project results are taken into account
